Arbol

While seafood and shellfish take center stage on the menu, flavorful curries, fine sushi and sashimi, Wagyu beef, vegetarian plates and an array of delectable desserts jockey for attention. Dishes emerge from Arbol's tandoor and charcoal ovens and simmering woks. Guests can also take a front row seat at the sensational raw bar, where delicacies flown in from around the globe include fresh lobster, stone crab, oysters and clams. Los Tres Gallos

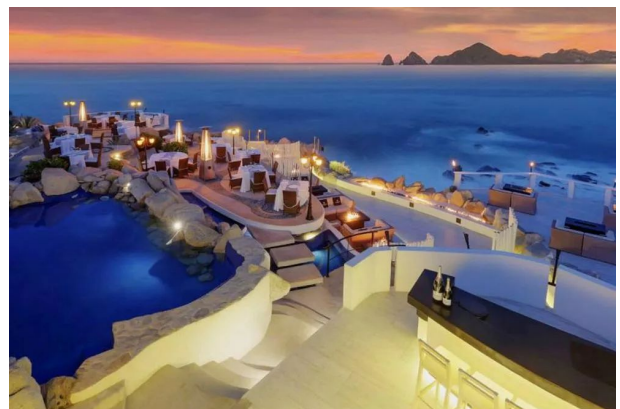
Hacienda Cocina & Cantina

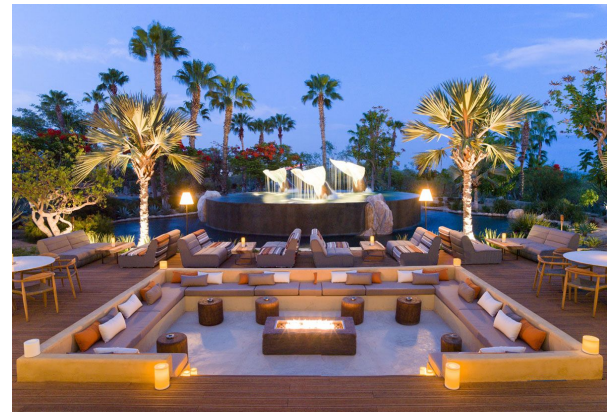
Bar Esquina

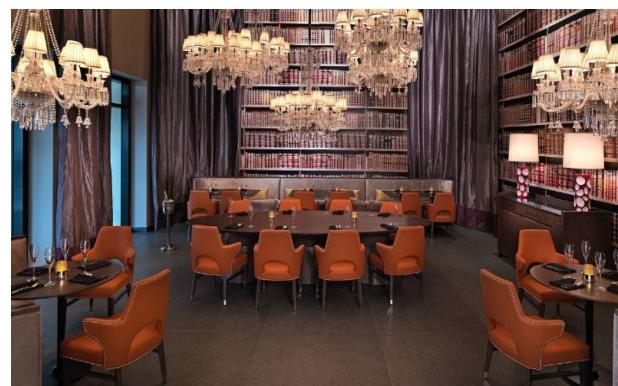
Toro by Richard Sandoval

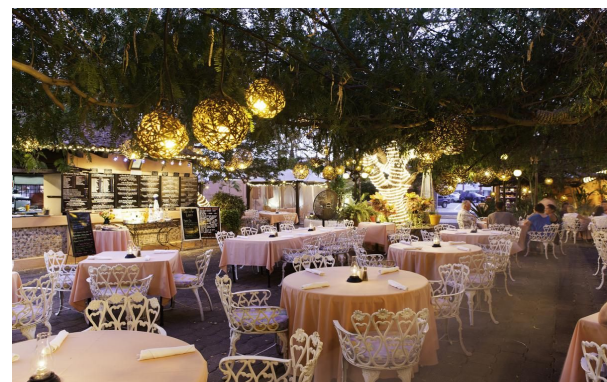
Maria Corona
